



### **Professor Dr. med. Michael Spannagl**

Michael Spannagl is professor at the Department of Transfusion Medicine, Cellular Therapeutics and Haemostaseology at the Ludwig Maximilian University of Munich (LMU) and well known for his work in the fields of haemostasis, intensive care and laboratory medicine. As head of the Haemostasis Division he is responsible for experimental, laboratory and clinical studies on anticoagulation, haemophilia therapy and patient blood management.

He is member of DIN/CEN/ISO committees on the standardization of medical laboratory diagnostics and quality management. He was secretary and vice-chairman of the German Society of Thrombosis and Haemostasis Research (GTH), and is the chairman of the German Society for Promoting Quality Assurance in the Medical Laboratories (INSTAND) as well as member of the National Advisory Committee Blood of the German Federal Ministry of Health. He has authored and co-authored more than 250 peer-reviewed articles and book chapters. As a board member of the German Medical Association, he has co-authored the German guidelines for treatments with blood components and plasma derivatives, as well as the guidelines for prophylaxis and treatment of venous thrombosis and pulmonary embolism. He is also an active member of several national and international scientific societies on haemostasis, transplantation and laboratory medicine as well as standardisation and quality management in the medical laboratory.
